The meeting was called to order by Rodney Caines, Chairman of the Board of Commissioners.

The minutes of 02/04/26 were approved.

The Board received a final summer help request for summer work. All spots for the year are filled now.

James reported that there was a main break on Maplewood Dr last night and a second one on Maplewood Dr this morning. Both have been repaired.

**THERE BEING NO FURTHER WATER DISTRICT BUSINESS TO DISCUSS, THE BOARD CLOSED THE WATER DISTRICT MEETING AND OPENED THE FIRE DISTRICT PORTION OF THE MEETING.**

Randee presented the Board with the updated Seagrave order. The Board denied the train horn but approved the rumbler. The order will be signed and sent back to Seagrave.

The Board approved the renewal of the Stryker Maintenance agreement.

The following Chiefs items were discussed:

1. The Fire Police are requesting to attend New York state fire police training and education seminar March 21<sup>st</sup>, 2026, at Fuller Road fire department Colonie New York. The room rate is \$117 and three members attending for total \$351. Registration fee is \$35 per member for three members total \$10. All together it will be \$456. (paperwork attached) **Approved.**
2. The Fire police are requesting to attend New York State Fire Police convention on May 14th-17th for three members. There will be one single room 3 nights at \$522 and one Double room 3 nights at \$714. Total \$1236. (Paperwork attached) **Approved.**
3. Follow up on Policies to be approved. We are still working with Joe and Randee on the callback policy. But looking to go forward on the policies discussed last week. **Approved.**

Chief Stewart inquired as to whether Assistant Chief Gjonlekaj will be protected to the extent possible by district insurance in regard to the car accident he had recently, the Board agreed yes he will be.

The attached vouchers for the Westbury Water District totaling \$125,602.11 and the Westbury Fire District totaling \$76,209.74 were approved for payment.
